- FAA we are not sending a letter
- DOD/NOAA we are not sending a letter
- EPA "Compliance with air and water quality standards under NEPA"
 - I would argue that a letter does not need to be sent to the EPA. We have never reached out to them unless we are working on or near Superfund site.
- IDEM Endangered Species
 - IDNR handles endangered species, not IDEM
 - IDEM handles air, water, and soil quality issues, we could ask them about these topics regarding the Project, but I don't know if we want to wade into that. I think it would be better if we just let the county know that IDNR handles endangered species.
- Private airport authorities permitted by FAA and IAA
 - IAA is the Indianapolis Airport Authority, I can't find an Indiana Airport Authority
 - There are records of three private airfield in the Project Area (Zeller, Hilakos, and Lewis) and two just beyond (Davis and Posey).
 - I would not recommend sending these folks a letter for comment without speaking to them first or knowing if they are in or out of the Project. We don't want a negative response about impacting someone's livelihood to be on the record, or hearing about it first in the response.
